POSITION OVERVIEW

HACKLEY SCHOOL seeks a Part-Time Teacher of Spanish to teach in the Middle and Upper Schools for a one-year appointment for the 2026-2027 academic year. The preferred candidate will have a strong background in the target language (bachelor's in Spanish required; graduate degree preferred). The ideal candidate has experience teaching Spanish at the middle and upper school levels. Candidates with experience and skill in teaching additional languages (e.g., French, Chinese, and/or Latin) are strongly encouraged to apply.

Teaching responsibilities for the 2026-2027 school year include one section of Spanish 7 in the Middle School and one section of Spanish I in the Upper School.

The Teacher of Spanish will report to the Modern Languages Department Chair, the Director of the Middle School and the Director of the Upper School.

Hackley challenges students to grow in character, scholarship, and accomplishment, to offer unreserved effort, and to learn from the varying perspectives and backgrounds in our community and the world.
