POSITION OVERVIEW

HACKLEY SCHOOL seeks an experienced Health and Physical Education teacher to be a leave replacement from January 2026 to June 2026. Teachers may teach up to four sections per school day. Additional opportunities exist to coach in the Middle and Upper School divisions for spring sports.

The Health and Physical Education Teacher reports to the Department Chair of Physical Education, Department Chair of Health Education, and the directors of the Middle and Upper Schools.

HACKLEY SCHOOL is a nonsectarian coeducational K-12 independent school located in Tarrytown, New York. Founded as a boarding school in 1899, Hackley enrolls approximately 860 students, including 25 five-day boarding students in grades 9-12.

- Promoting and managing a healthy learning environment that motivates and inspires students to participate and learn new skills.
- Demonstrating the ability to coach a variety of sports, such as squash, softball, and track and field.
- Assuming and fulfilling additional duties as required by the position.

The ideal candidate embodies the School's core values and models them for others. The ideal candidate will possess:

- Experience teaching Physical Education in a K-12 learning environment.
- Undergraduate degree in Physical Education or Health Education; master's degree preferred.
- Experience in swim instruction; lifeguarding certificate preferred.
- Knowledge of the National and New York State Teaching Standards for Physical Education.
