POSITION OVERVIEW

HACKLEY SCHOOL seeks an Upper School math teacher for the 2026-2027 school year. The Upper School math teacher is responsible for teaching at least four Mathematics classes in Hackley's Upper School. The preferred candidate will have an appropriate background (undergraduate degree required; graduate degree preferred) and teaching experience. Candidates should have an abiding interest in the academic, social and emotional well-being of students; be willing to work collaboratively with the Math Department and the broader faculty community; and be interested in contributing to the extracurricular life at Hackley (which could include coaching, club advising, etc.).

The Upper School math teacher reports to the Math Department Chair and the Director of the Upper School.



MISSION AND HISTORY

HACKLEY SCHOOL is a nonsectarian coeducational K-12 independent school located in Tarrytown, New York. Founded as a boarding school in 1899, Hackley enrolls approximately 860 students, including 25 five-day boarding students in grades 9-12.

Students experience joy in the classroom and make life-long connections with each other and with our dedicated faculty, 40% of whom reside on campus. Robust extracurricular programming on our 285-acre campus creates unique opportunities for each student to learn and grow beyond the boundaries of the school day. Hackley graduates have the knowledge and confidence to pursue their passions and the drive to make a difference.

Hackley challenges students to grow in character, scholarship, and accomplishment, to offer unreserved effort, and to learn from the varying perspectives and backgrounds in our community and the world.

ROLE RESPONSIBILITIES

The Upper School math teacher's responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Lesson planning, development and assignment of student learning activities, student assessment, record keeping, grading, and grade reporting.
- Creation of a warm and engaging classroom environment.
- Active, positive and professional participation in all faculty meetings.
- Effective communication with students, colleagues and families.
- Participation and support for the growth of the department's instructional program.
- A teaching load based on faculty strengths and departmental needs.
- Other division-based responsibilities, such as advising students, as assigned by the division director.

SALARY AND BENEFITS

The salary range for this 10-month faculty position is \$76,226–\$116,239, with experience informing a base salary as published in Hackley's faculty salary stage scale.
